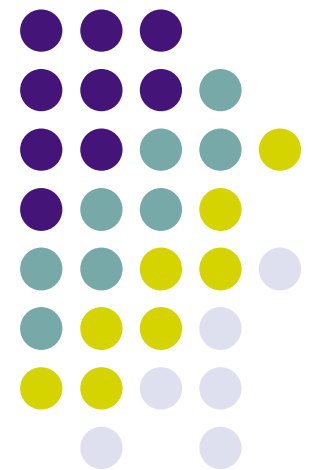
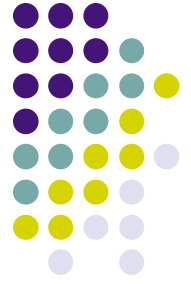

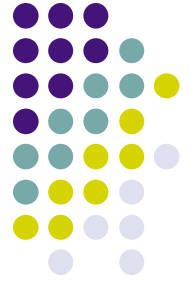




# Trends Observed

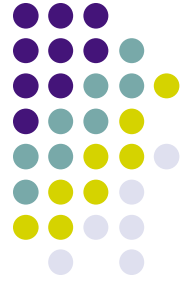
- Photocopying for distribution

# SummerTech Camp

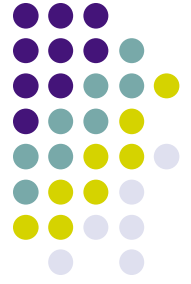


- Lincoln Park, Loop, and Barat Campuses

- Blackboard links in “external resources”, assignments, etc.



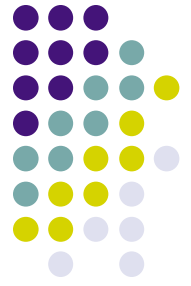
# Training faculty to link

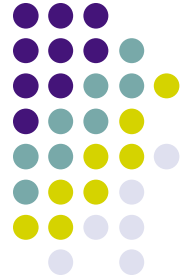

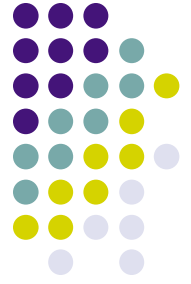
# Linking directly to articles
